

Development of education package for Nursing Staff

- Timing Nursing Education Calendar
- Location Dependent on admission data
- Impact Written, Verbal, Practical, AV
- **Content** Respiration, Humidification, Swallowing, Communication, General Nursing Care, Emergency Management and Troubleshooting


